

Illinois Residency Verification

Since you or your student's file was selected for Federal Verification and you or your student appears to be eligible for the State of Illinois Monetary Award Program (MAP) Grant, Illinois regulation requires you to provide documentation indicating Illinois is your permanent residence.

For Dependent Students (parental information is required on the FAFSA): Please provide only **one** of the following items for the parent of the dependent student:

- Illinois Driver's license
- Illinois Tax Return 2017*
- W-2 2017
- Final Illinois High School or Illinois College transcript for the student*
- Most recent Utility or rent bill
- Valid Illinois auto registration card
- Current statement(s) of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Public Aid*
- Residential lease*
- Current statement(s) of benefits from the Illinois Department of Employment Security*
- Current statement(s) of benefits from the Social Security Administration*
- Illinois Voter's registration Card
- Most recent property tax bill displaying residential address

Independent Students (parental information is not required on the FAFSA): Provide documentation from one of the asterisk (*) items above showing you resided in Illinois for 12 continuous full months immediately prior to the start of the academic year. Illinois must be your true, fixed and permanent home.

Under penalty of Illinois Law, I confirm I am a permanent resident of the State of Illinois.
