#### **Biographical Note**

Elmer Morton "Turk" Edwards was born August 25, 1918 in Danville, Illinois. He graduated from Millikin in 1942 with a degree in Business Administration. While at Millikin, Edwards was a member of Delta Chapter, Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity, and served as Chapter Advisor for several years. In 1943, Edwards married Belva Curry in Decatur, they had two children (Carol and Nancy). Edwards served in the Army in the European Theater during WWII; he was awarded many medals for his service. Edwards also worked in public accounting for several years, then he served as comptroller at Millikin for five years. Edwards then went on work as the Business Manager of the University of Illinois Press for 21 years. He retired in 1985, and devoted more time to volunteer work and work within the Champaign-Urbana Kiwanis Club. Edwards died in December of 2008.

### **Scope and Content Note**

Some of this ephemera is ceramic, and fragile. These pieces are wrapped in newspaper. These ephemera items do not contain any personal information about Edwards. They are commemorative objects surrounding the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity, and Millikin University.
