Biographical Note

Evelyn Scott (1899-1966), of Chrisman, Illinois, graduated from Millikin in 1921, with a B.S. in Household Arts. In 1917-1918, she attended Western College of Oxford, Ohio, transferring to Millikin as a sophomore in 1918. She was a member of Delta Delta Delta, Pi Mu Theta, Gamma Epsilon Tau (science honorary fraternity) and of the Household Arts Club (1919-1920).

Scope and Content Note

Scrapbook includes sewing examples, clippings, and patterns, with handwritten descriptions glued to adjacent pages. Also included are a few newspaper/magazine clippings related to topics of household management. Similar to the Marie Nina Shaw scrapbook, but with fewer sewing examples, and more clippings, drawings. Stuck in the back of the scrapbook appears to be a newborn baby wristband for Rosann Yelton.
