#### **Biographical Note**

Evelyn Wait (1896-1972?) was originally from Greenville, Illinois and graduated from Millikin in 1921. She was a member of Sigma Alpha Iota (music sorority) and spent most of her time at Millikin pursuing certificates in music.

As a student, she received her degree in piano playing (1921), certificate in piano playing (1919), certificate in public school music (1920), certificate in harmony (1920), certificate in singing (1921), was a member of the Girls' Glee Club (1917-1920) and acted as president from 1919-1920. She was also a member of the Millidek Board from 1919-1920.

#### **Scope and Content Note**

This collection is comprised of invitations to social events, school sponsored and personal. There are many recital and performance programs from 1917-1921. Photographs are scarce and are primarily contained in the first few pages of the scrapbook (all are campus photographs).

Much of what is in the scrapbook is ephemera from the events she attended, including Sigma Alpha Iota events. Ms. Wait also noted particular information concerning the contents of the scrapbook, around the items themselves. There are also some newspaper clippings that include her and fellow students.
