Biographical Note

Dr. John R. Miltner served as Millikin University's tenth president for fourteen months from 1991-1992. He was an undergraduate at Bowling Green State University in Ohio, where he majored in education, and went on to earn a master's degree in business administration from New York's Pace University and a doctorate in philanthropy and leadership at the Union Institute in Cincinnati. Before serving as Millikin's president, he was assistant vice president and director of development for Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York City and then vice chancellor for university advancement at the University of California-Irvine. Previous positions included executive director of development and communications for the Boy Scouts of America and national chair of the board for the National Society of Fund-Raising Executives. He also worked in marketing for Docutel Corp. and IBM. During his short time as president, Miltner supported initiatives to diversify and modernize Millikin. He died due to complications from skin cancer at age 46 on September 6th, 1992.
