#### **Biographical Note**

Ralph Allan graduated from Millikin University in and was a part of the faculty from 1937-39, and again from 1947-81. In 1979 he was granted the status of Professor Emeritus. He was the Millikin Men's basketball coach, as well as the Athletic Director during his time at Millikin. He led the men's basketball team to the national championship in Kansas City in 1951, finishing second in the nation. The Decatur Indoor Sports Center (DISC) co-named a weightlifting and cardiovascular center in honor of Allan. A scholarship fund was also established by Allan's family and friends and is annually awarded to a deserving student. His wife, Ellen Allan taught English at Millikin from 1959-1964.

#### Scope and Content Note

The majority of the collection chronicles the 1951 basketball season and contains many telegraph messages written to Allan and the team, encouraging them to do their best in the N.A.I.B. playoffs. There are also newspaper clippings and professional photographs included in the scrapbook. It is not known who assembled the scrapbook.

#### Series Notes

*Series 1: Scrapbook* 2 items Large, black leather-bound scrapbook containing photos and telegrams relating to the Kansas City basketball tourneys in 1951, 1952. Large, brown leather scrapbook- "Big Blue Basketball with Scott Steagall."
