The Office of Public Safety is responsible for a wide variety of functions and consists of sworn police officers, non-sworn security officers and student workers (Blue Patrol).

During patrols, both Police and Security Officers are establishing a presence to deter criminal activity, conducting life safety checks and proactively engaging our community members. Public Safety staff members attend regular training on procedures, investigations, report writing, crisis management, first aid and CPR/AED.
