

### Millikin BSN Nursing Requirements for Richland Transfer Students – Updated July 2023

To be able to be admitted directly into the BSN Nursing program at Millikin, a student must meet the following requirements:

- Required nursing prerequisite courses:

- At least a 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA
- Earn a grade of C- or better in all courses required for the major (*no more than one fail/withdraw/repeat*)
- Have earned a grade of C- or better in at least 3 out of 4 of the following science prerequisites (CH203/205, BI 206, BI 207, BI 230) (noting Millikin's CH203/205 has a pre-requisite of CH114)
- Meet health standards required by the School of Nursing and affiliating agencies
- Display appropriate professional behavior
- Progress in a timely manner

**General Information about Millikin's BSN Program:**

- Nursing block begins second semester of sophomore year and will take 5 semesters total to complete
- Nursing major courses must be completed at Millikin University
- If A.A. or A.S. degree is completed prior to transferring, multiple classes will be waived including:
  - IN140: University Seminar
  - EN181: University Writing
  - EN281: Writing in the Disciplines
  - IN 250: U.S. Cultural Studies
  - IN 251: U.S. Structural Studies
  - Creative Arts
  - International Cultures & Structures
  - Natural Science with a Laboratory
  - Oral Communication Studies
  - Quantitative Reasoning
- Students who have completed an A.A. or A.S. degree must complete at Millikin:
  - Global Studies requirement
  - Any remaining nursing pre-requisites
  - Nursing specific courses
