 - Campus contingency plans

 - Hiring for Assistant to the Dean for Enrollment Management
 - Shauna's last day was February 14.
 - Najiba & Becky have interviewed several candidates and hope to have someone in place by early April.
 - Hiring for Center for Entrepreneurship Director
 - Hope to have an Interim Director in place by April, to serve through the end of 2020 or spring of 2021; launching a national search this fall for a permanent replacement.
