

Advising Long Vanderburg Students, Spring 2024

For those of you who advise Long Vanderburg Scholars, below is the 8-semester plan required by the program. LV students take a total number of 18 credits, summarized as follows:

- LV 100 Summer Leadership Academy, 1 credit
- EN 181 University Writing/LV section, 3 credits
- Four courses tagged by the Registrar with the LV attribution, 3 credits each, for a total of 12 credits
- Two senior capstone courses, 1 credit each, for a total of 2 credits
